**ASIA-EUROPE INSTITUTE (AEI) INVITES APPLICATIONS FOR MASTERS PROGRAMMES FOR THE SESSION BEGINNING SEPT: 2014**

I am pleased to inform that Asia-Europe Institute, University of Malaya, invites applications by graduate students of any discipline from the **University Politehnica of Bucharest** to do a Masters degree or PhD programme at AEI. Application online is open and would close by the end of May 2014.

The AEI is a Malaysian Government postgraduate centre for Social Sciences which had been established within the ASEM (Asia-Europe Meeting) process. It was based on a proposal made by the then Prime Minister of Malaysia, Tun Dr. Mahathir Mohamad at the first ASEM Summit in 1996 aimed at enhancing international cooperation in the field of higher education.

As such, AEI conducts four International programmes and appoints many Visiting Professors from Europe to lecture at AEI. The four Masters programmes are:

1. International Masters in Information Management (IMIM);
2. International Masters in Regional Integration (IMRI);
3. International Masters in Small-and-Medium Enterprises (IMSME); and
4. International Masters in ASEAN Studies (IMAS).

We would be grateful if your good office could nominate one or two students to do the Masters or PhD at AEI. Application is online at <http://www.ips.um.edu.my>.

Candidates would need to have a good first degree in any discipline with CGPA 3.30 minimum and English proficiency of at least TOEFL 550.

We are also pleased to mention that candidates with at least the above qualification would be offered financial assistance. The financial assistance would include air-fare to Malaysia and per diem.

The Masters programmes would begin in September 2014 for a period of one year to cover 44 credit hours. This would also include an Internship of about two months whose cost would be borne by AEI.

Successful candidates would be awarded with the degree issued by the University of Malaya, the oldest and the leading university in Malaysia.
